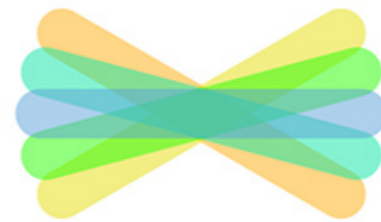

What is Seesaw?

Seesaw is an app that allows teachers to share work and assignments with students.



CLASS

Students complete assignments and activities in Seesaw and send it back to their teacher.

Students can show their learning by adding photos, videos, text, drawings or voice recording.

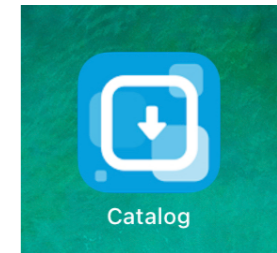


How to Set Up Seesaw for Distance Learning

#1: Open the Seesaw app.

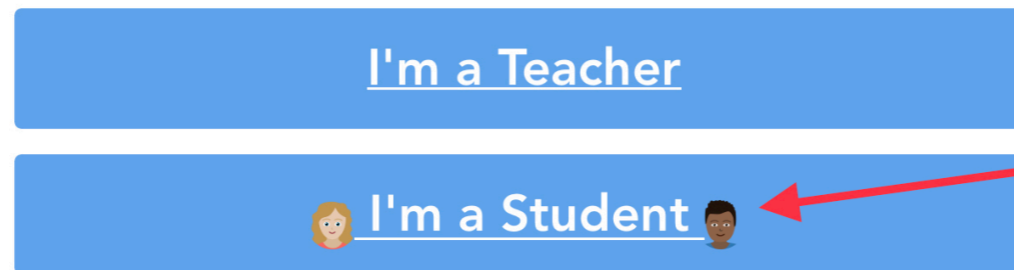


If you don't have the app, download it from the App Catalog.

#3: Enter your Home Learning Code that was shared by the teacher.

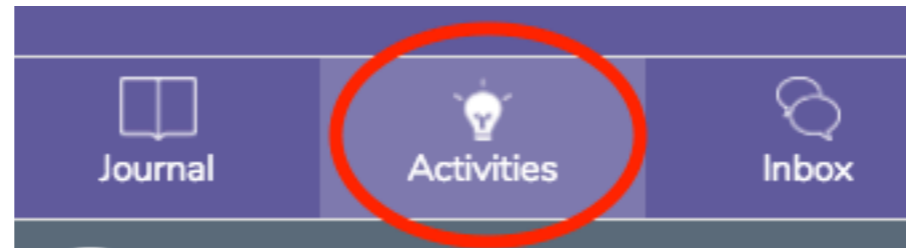

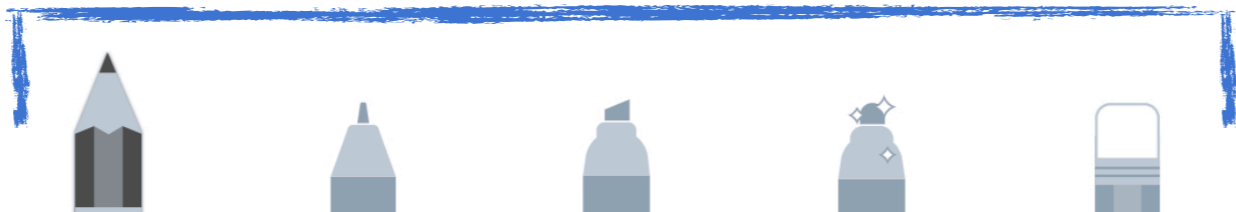
