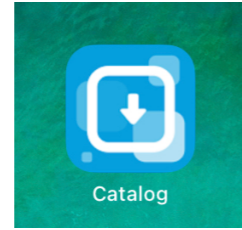

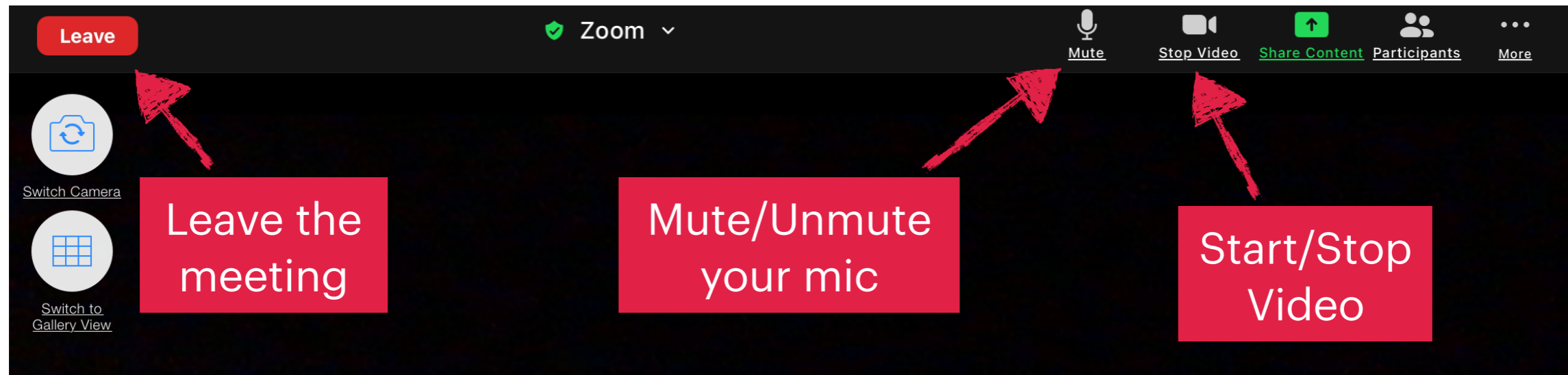
#3: Enter your first and last name.

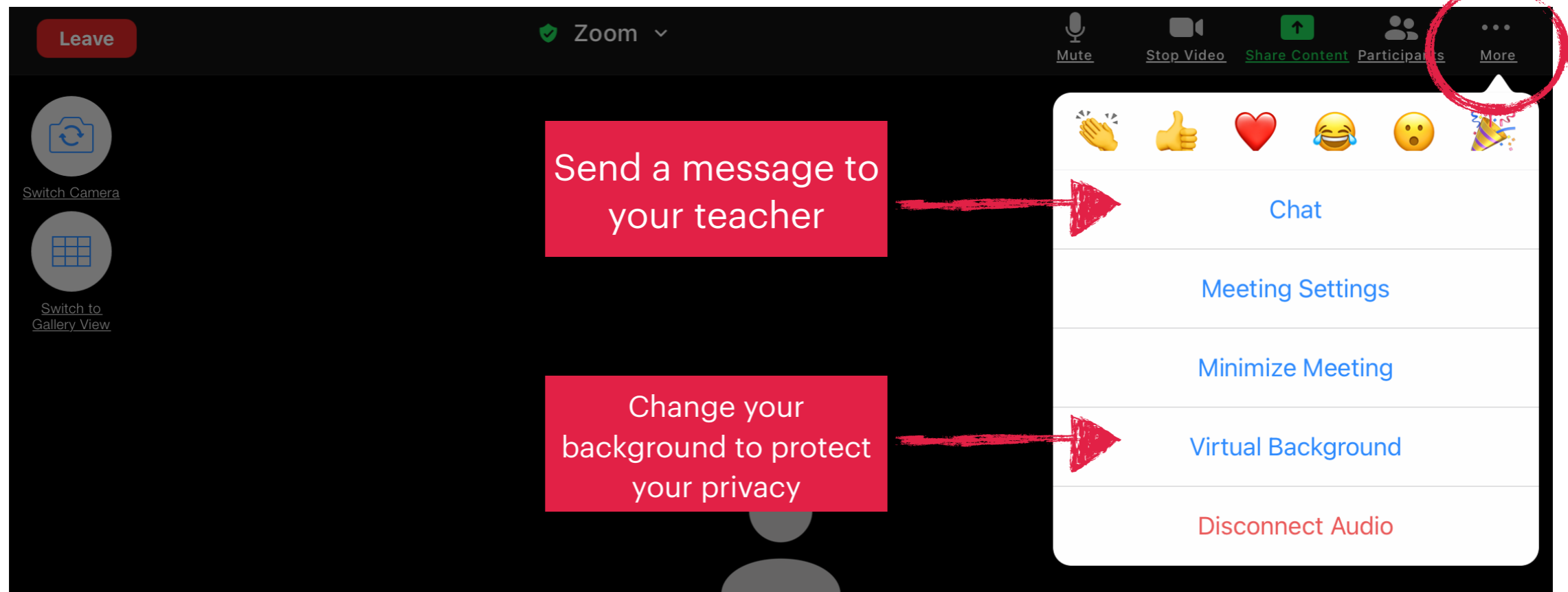

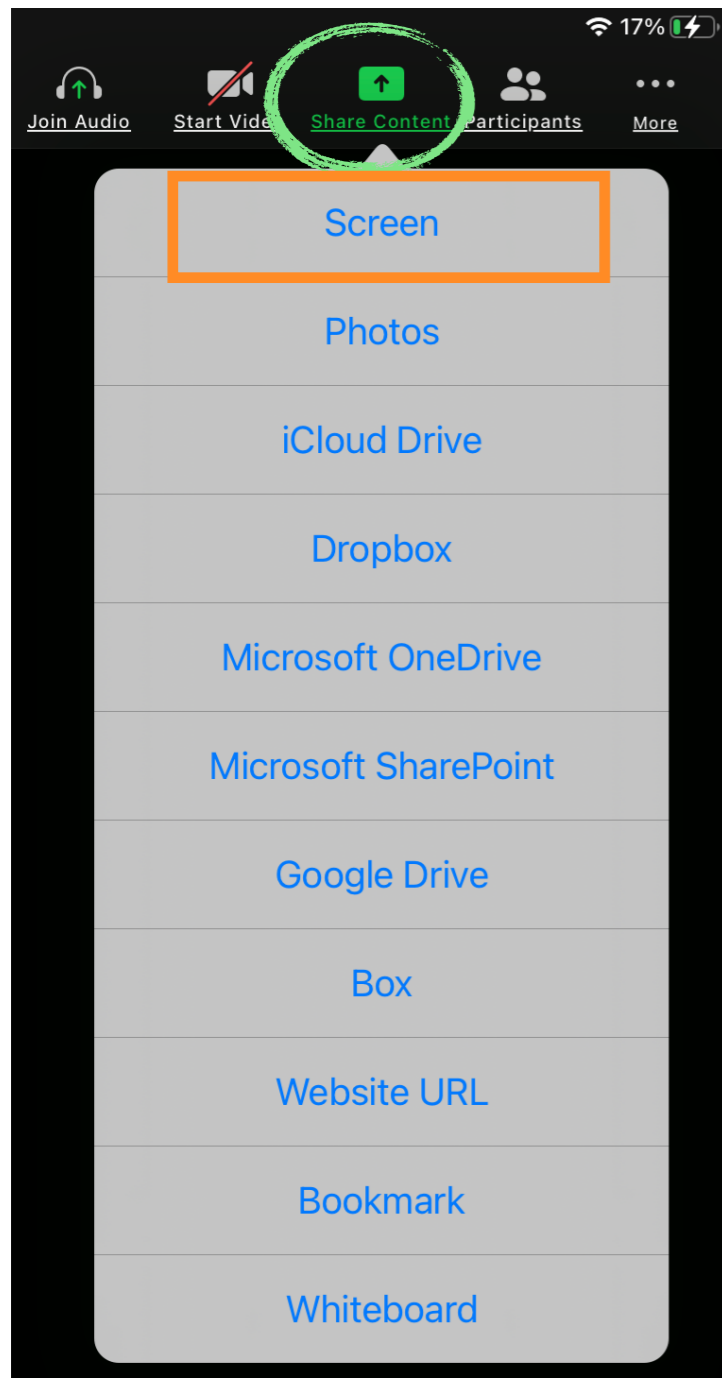


Click *More* to chat with your teacher or change your background.

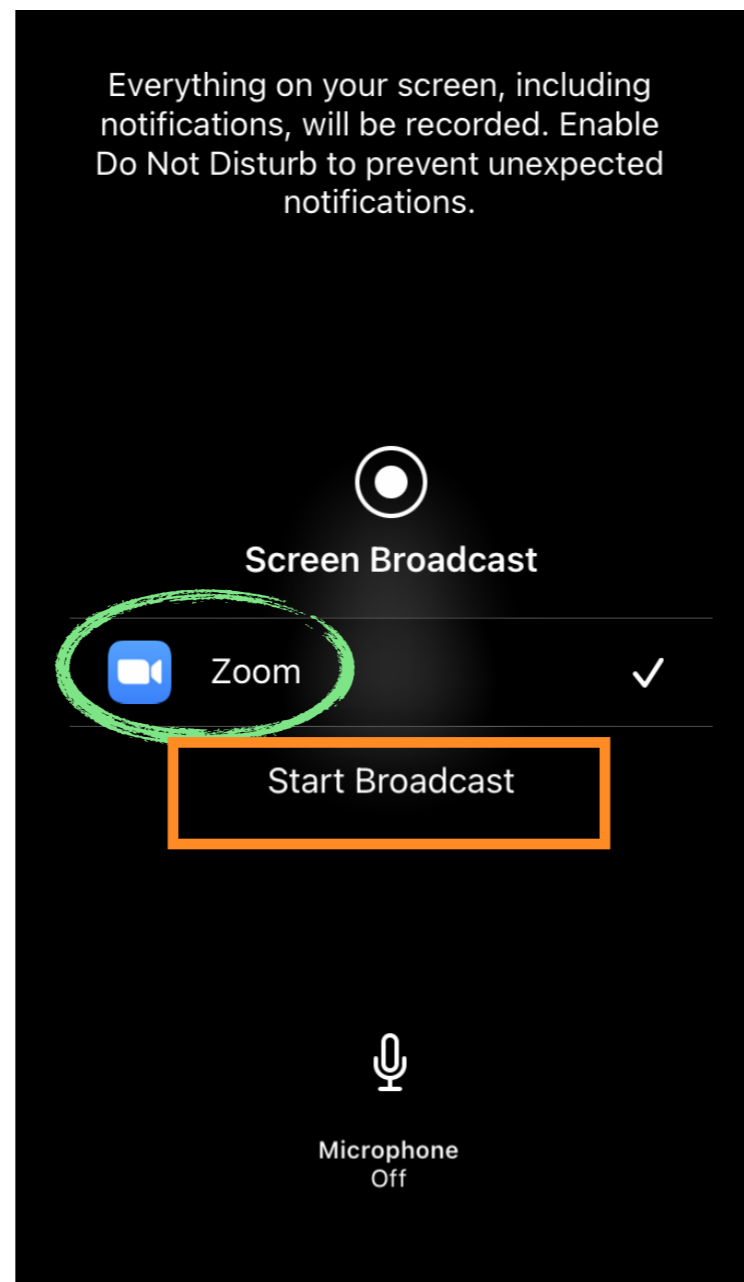


How to Share Your Screen

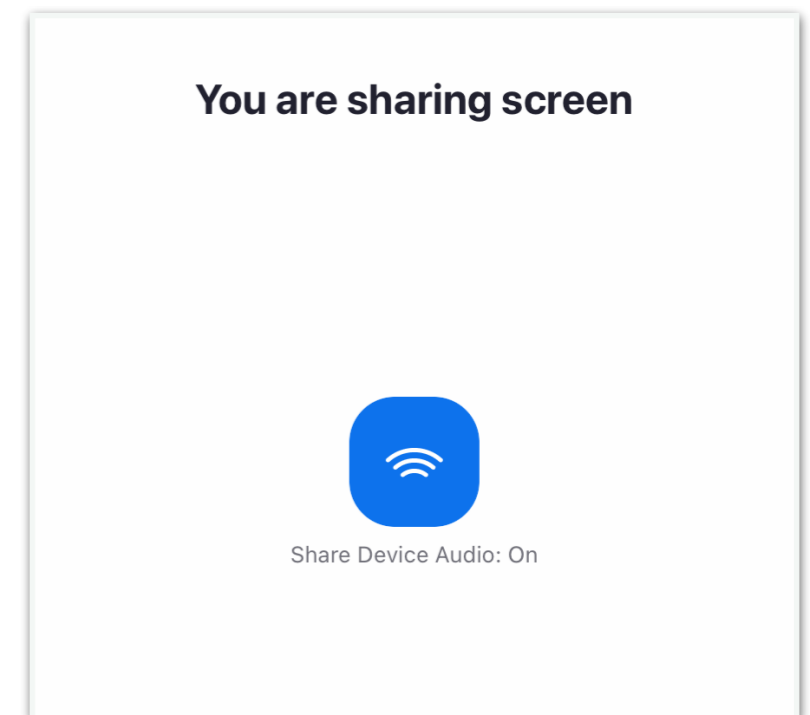
#1: Click *Share Content*, then *Screen*.



#2: Select *Zoom* then *Start Broadcast*

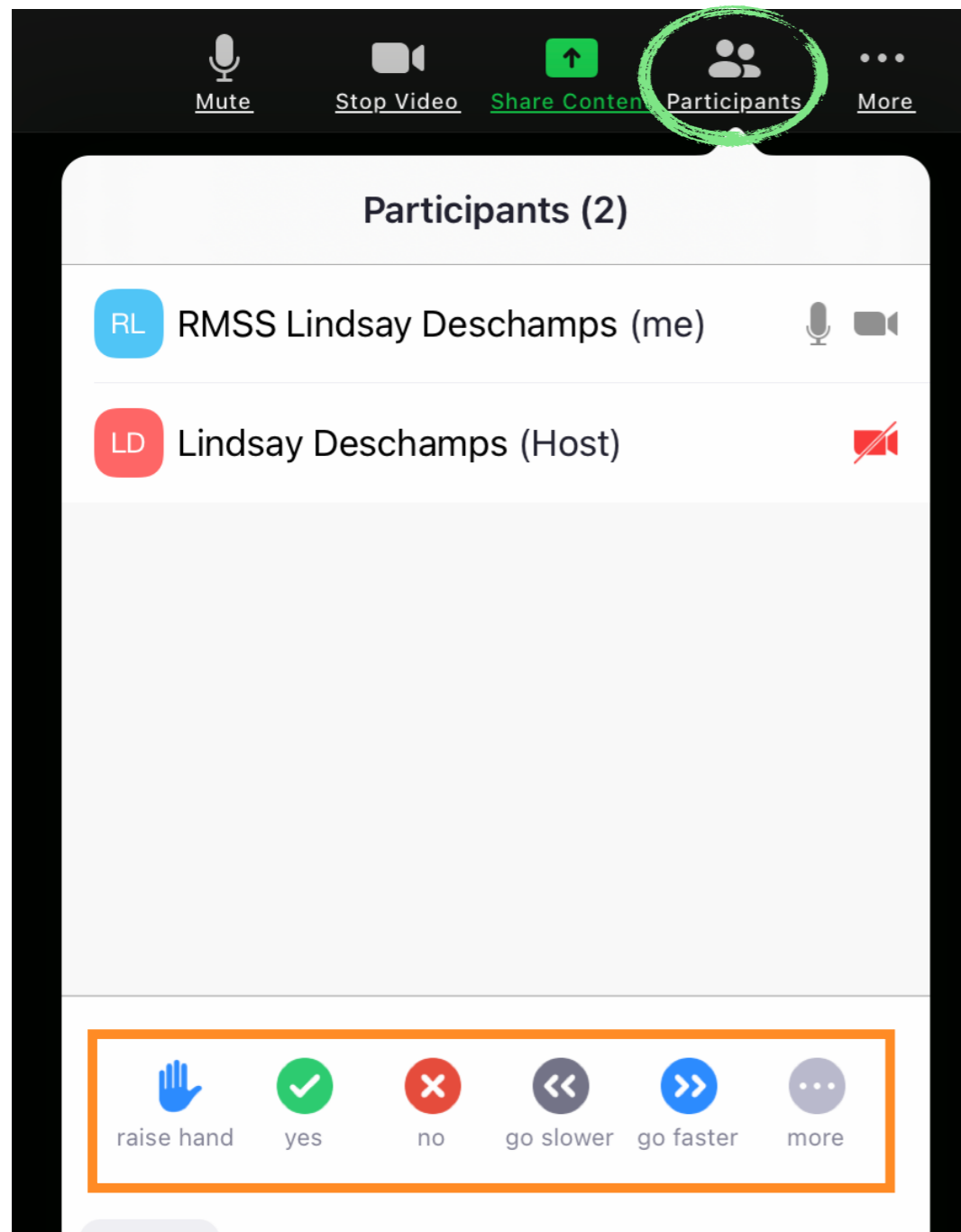


#3: You are now sharing your screen. Anything you do on your iPad will be shared.

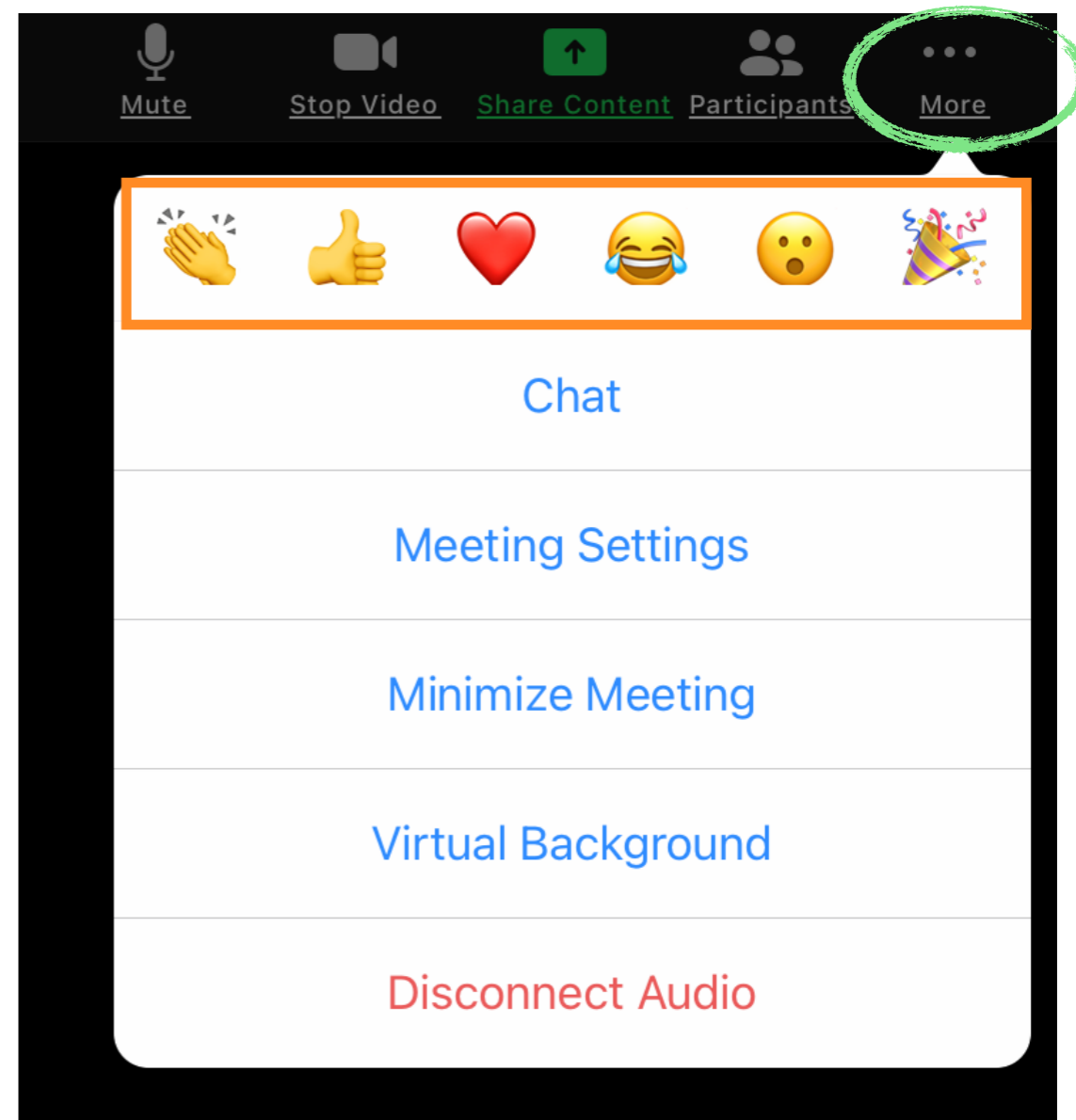


How to Participate While on Mute
